Hello Winchmore Hill residents,

After long discussions with WHRA the good news is the Produce Show is going ahead, albeit in a slightly different way! So everyone will have the chance to showcase their lockdown efforts in their gardens and at their crafting tables!

Sadly, this year there are no bakery or cookery classes because of the complexities of judging. We have, however, added extra classes to the fruit and vegetable categories and a photography section for children. It would be great to see lots of entries this year — the more entries we have, the better the show!

To run the show within current guidelines, the following rules will apply:-

- 1. Entries to be dropped off on Friday afternoon / evening.
- 2. Entries will be received at the gate of the hall there will be no entry to the hall itself
- 3. Access to the hall will only be permitted for those running the show
- 4. Flowers and leafy vegetable entries only to be dropped off on Saturday morning
- 5. Judging as normal between 10am & 12pm
- 6. The tables displaying all the produce and crafts will be carried out of the hall and placed in the marquee on the common
- 7. Around 1pm, the sides of the marquee will be raised (weather dependent of course!) to allow everyone to circulate around the tables and see the results.
- 8. This viewing will be strictly one-way and numbers limited in the marquee at any one time
- 9. Those wishing to collect their entries will be able to from 4pm to allow enough time for everyone to get around the 'show'
- 10. Entries not collected will be disposed of
- 11. No auction at the end of the show

Important to notes for all entrants!

- Fully complete an entry form for every class that you are entering.
- Deliver all entries with completed entry forms in a box to the gate of the hall
- Drop-off on Friday 4th September 4pm 8pm
- ONLY leafy vegetables and flowers to be dropped off on Saturday 5th September 8.30am 9am

There will be no crafting workshops this year as everyone with children will understand that this would be just too hard to manage with the current social distancing measures in place. We have tried to keep the children's art categories as cost effective and simple as possible to allow for this. If you're stuck for ideas, don't hesitate to contact us or use trusty Pinterest... an absolute wealth of inspiration for budding artists!
